In accordance with the requirements of Virginia Tech, a basic background check will be performed on all class participants prior to this participation.

Classes will be held from 6:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m. Monday evenings, beginning January 27, 2025 at the Southwest Virginia Higher Education Center in Abingdon, I-81 exit 14.

The price of the class is \$109, which includes a copy of the Master Gardener Handbook.

Two people may register for \$185 if they share one handbook. Maximum class size is 30. Registration ends January 15, 2025
